



## **GUIDE TO PACKING LIQUIDS**


## Forwarding risks in the PPL CZ system




Automatic sorting lines sort up to 200,000 parcels per day! Adapt packaging to suit these automated lines. Risks of falling and impact!




**Liquids packed in cans.**Secure caps against opening with adhesive tape or shrink wrap.



High risk of snap-on caps popping off!



**Liquids packed in glass containers.**Secure contents against movement.



Liquids packed in plastic packaging.

Create sufficient crumple zones around the entire contents.

## Guide to packing liquids:

- 1. Use high-quality packaging materials and boxes.
- 2. Secure caps with adhesive tape or shrink wrap.
- 3. Wrap each item in bubble wrap, etc.
- 4. Separate individual items.
- 5. Place the whole content in a bag/sack and close it.
- 6. Create sufficient crumple zones around the entire contents thickest base + top.
- 7. Secure contents against movement.
- 8. The whole parcel must be strong and compact.
- 9. Test the parcel by dropping it from 60 80 cm (CSN EN 22248 a 24180-20).
- The parcel must be able to withstand 5 times its own weight.
- 11. Mark with a handling label according to CSN EN ISO 780.
- 12. Secure authenticity of packaging with a highquality seal.
